Detailed Ateliers Program

These ateliers are meant for dancers, professionals or amateurs, as well as musicians or any interested person.

SPANISH DANCE OF THE GOLDEN AGE

Work on Golden Age Spanish dance described in the sources from the XVIth to the XVIIIth centuries, based in particular on the works of Esquivel, Jaque, González and Novelí.

Practice of the basic steps and arm movements, with or without castanets. Practice of the choreographic variations proposed in the mentioned sources. And finally, improvisation and composition exercises will be proposed, for a better understanding of the different dance types and their dynamics.

This year's Sundays Ateliers repertoire will be centered on studying some choreographic restitution from the sources as well as creating our own mudanzas of certain types of dance.

Concerning which dances to study from the sources, we would like to ask you, the students, where is your interest for this year. We will decide on the subjects after getting your personal wishes.

Concerning the pieces on which to improvise and to create our own mudanzas, we will do it on pieces like *Folías*, *Canarios* and *Chacona*.

We will also explore our own *mudanzas* for a *Zarabanda*.

The restitutions will be done applying to the arm movements from the Novelí figures and the González arms descriptions in the choreographic sources. The work concentrates on the dance technique, style, interpretation and, of course, on the relation between music and dance. We will also play **castanets** while dancing, for those who want.

SPANISH TRADITIONAL DANCE OF MAYORCA AND MENORCA

During the Autumn Ateliers, we will have **Sebastià Bover** teaching us some steps and figures of Spanish traditional dances from Mallorca and Menorca, including the *Jota*, *Bolero* and *Fandango* from Mallorca and Menorca.

One can see many common steps, arm movements and figures between those 2 styles: Spanish Golden Age dance and the Traditional dance. That is why we offer you this combination for the Autumn Trimester.

The possibilities of improvisation in the *Jota* (which reshape spaces and offer numerous variations of basic steps) make this dance one of the most widespread and common in Mallorca. We will primarily work on the style passed down through families, with a nod to the transformations made later in public squares.

We can revise the *Bolero "de Ciutadella"* from last year, example of a well-preserved bolero that has been transmitted from generation to generation in Ciutadella (Menorca).

To complete and determine the program, we are interested in knowing your wishes.

All levels admitted.

NB: If you do not have castanets but you wish to play them, it would be useful to get a pair.
